## NASA in Aberdeen

SPE Aberdeen were founders as well as organisers and provided seed funding for “NASA in Aberdeen”, helping young people to focus on science and technology careers.

Over 12,500 attended inspiring events involving a team of NASA Astronauts, Engineers and Scientists in close collaboration with the Energy Institute, the Society for Underwater Technology, Aberdeen Science Centre, TechFest, the Scottish Space School Federation, schools across Aberdeen city and shire, sponsored by Apollo, BP, Equinor, CNOOC, Oceaneering and TAQA, supported by Skene House, M&G, Carjon-NRG - and of course NASA personnel.

This program has now evolved into “Space to Energy” led by TechFest and ASC and “Explorers – Inspiring the Next Generation” led by SPE Aberdeen, El AHI and Carjon-NRG.

Each year, SPE Aberdeen provide annual bursaries of up to £20,000 to support students studying oil and gas related qualifications, relieving the financial stresses faced by students and allowing them to focus on their studies.
