ALIGN TOWARDS A COLLABORATIVE APPROACH



The ECITB, in association with the Oil & Gas UK Efficiency Task Force (OGUK ETF) are calling for Operators, Service Providers and wider supply chain organisations to register a current or planned project which intends to align to the key principles of collaboration, utilising the ECITB Project Collaboration Toolkit (PCT).

The PCT was developed by Industry for Industry through the ECITB Offshore Project Management Steering Group (OPMSG) and serves as a practical tool which provides guidance on how to achieve or improve collaboration for the benefit of projects. The specific PCT focus is on the behavioural aspects of project management. The PCT features in the Robust Project Delivery chapter within the [OGA's Asset Stewardship Expectations](#).

What we're looking for:

A selection of Oil & Gas projects, (which may include Capital Projects, Turnarounds, Modification Interventions, Decommissioning projects or discrete scopes) of varying size and complexity that would benefit from a collaborative strategy and where such a strategy has the support of the 'Lead Project Entity'. The project can be at any place within the lifecycle as the PCT can be used from inception through to completion or for individual phases of activity. Consultative support towards the project will be provided throughout 2017 and depending on the nature of the project, may run for up to 12 months.

Support will be provided to enable project parties to perform against all / or part of the following PCT phases:

- Establishing a Collaborative Environment
- Setting up the Project for Collaboration
- Executing Collaborative Project
- Close out and Learn

What help you will receive: Our commitment to you

- Expert consultancy funded by the ECITB to provide practical training and support in adopting the collaborative principles for the project including facilitation & evaluation workshops. The level of support provided will be proportionate to the size and scope of the project, and will commence in 2017.
- Training and development of the team members across all project parties in collaborative behaviours with a view to creating 'Industry Champions' within your organisations.
- Effective data sharing & feedback to all parties to enable current and future effective collaboration.
