


#### Cessation of Production – the licensees' perspective

- Formal agreement to permanently cease oil or gas production from a field
  - Early engagement with the OGA is important, especially for complex fields
  - Fundamental premise is that the field is uneconomic and that there are no remaining development opportunities






#### Case Study - SNS Viking Fields



- Discovered in 1965
- First production in 1972
- Last production in 2015
- 5 Viking Fields, developed from 10 platforms
- 3.26 Tscf gas produced



#### Case Study - SNS Viking B Field




- Discovery well drilled in 1965
- Field comprises three reservoirs; B, C, and D
- First production in 1973, last production in 2011
- 14 wells drilled to develop the field, cumulative production of 861 Bscf






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
Pre-tax Casf flow (£MM)


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







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## Last production in 2011






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- Field summary
