NASA in Aberdeen — SPE is working to "Inspire the Next Generation" of young people to focus on science and technology careers — in close collaboration with the Energy Institute, the Society for Underwater Technology, Aberdeen Science Centre, TechFest, the Scottish Space School Federation, schools across Aberdeen city and shire, oil and gas sponsors Apollo, BP, Equinor, CNOOC, Oceaneering and TAQA - and of course NASA.

SPE Aberdeen plays a critical role in the development of Inside Industry, a career guidance

website which is targeted specifically towards the energy industry. It is the only tool of its kind focused on providing first class, industry driven career information and advice and has been rolled out across 300 schools in Scotland.

Each year, SPE Aberdeen provide annual bursaries of up to £20,000 to support students studying oil and gas related qualifications, relieving the financial stresses faced by students and allowing them to focus on their studies.

















Part of the calendar of events funding these projects is the Offshore Achievement Awards (OAAs).

Now in its 35th year, the OAAs recognise outstanding achievements in the offshore energy industry.
