CALL FOR ABSTRACTS - DEADLINE 19TH NOVEMBER 2021

Building upon the success of SPE Aberdeen and PESGB's inaugural Carbon Capture, Utilisation and Storage technical event in 2020 we are pleased to announce the CCUS virtual conference for 2022.

CCUS is an essential component of delivering the UK Government's 2050 Net Zero promise. The full-chain process of

capturing, treating, compressing, utilising, transporting and injecting CO₂ deep underground will require all the skills that exist in the oil and gas industry. All these skills can be re-purposed to plan and deliver successful CCUS projects within commercial models that are either being developed by regulators and governments or are already in existence in some countries.

The SPE/PESGB CCUS 2022 conference aims to focus on the key technical issues through four themes and will discuss the technical solutions required to achieve the goals of the 26th UN Climate Change Conference of the Parties (COP26) being held in Glasgow in November 2021

/// POLICY, REGULATIONS AND BUSINESS MODELS

Two of the COP26 goals is to **Mobilise Finance** and ask countries to come forward with ambitious 2030 emissions reductions targets. As part of this, innovative thinking will be required on how to accelerate adoption of CCUS with attractive **business models**. In parallel, national and international **regulations** will be required such as **carbon pricing**.

/// WELLS

Designing wells for the different challenges of injecting CO₂ is a relatively undeveloped skill set for most, so drilling and completion engineers face a range of new challenges. The OGA requires operators to assess the **re-use of old wells** and reservoirs for CCUS before Cessation of Production, so **material** selection and the qualification of completion equipment will require Supply Chain and operators to collaborate closely.

/// CHOOSING STORAGE LOCATIONS

As with conventional oil and gas, CCUS starts and ends with the rocks. How do we choose storage locations and balance the conflicting benefits and challenges of repurposed '**brownfield**' versus undisturbed '**greenfield**' reservoirs and aquifers?

/// OPERATIONS AND INFRASTRUCTURE

What are the challenges of **operating and monitoring** CCUS facilities? What are the material and fluid property challenges? Share your operating experience from **capture** sites through to **transport** infrastructure, **EOR** and injection facilities. For those planning a new CCUS programme where do you see the main issues?
